LOTF Ch 1-2

Directions: Below is a table with 3 columns. The first column includes one of your vocab words from this week. The second column tells you the position of the vocab word in the sentence (e.g. if the word is “fish” and the number is 3, then “fish” needs to be the third word in the sentence). The third column tells you your sentence length (e.g. if this column says 9, then your sentence must have exactly 9 words; if it says “less than 7,” then your sentence should have less than 7 words). See the example below for clarification. **DO NOT CHANGE THE FORM OF THE WORD--** you may only use the form given to you.
