

LOTF Map Assignment

Learning Target: I can use my knowledge of the book, as well as understanding of quotes, to draw a detailed map of the island that reflects my understanding of the text.

Complete the activity below to find quotes that describe the setting of the island. In your next class, you will be creating a map of the island. You do not have to be an artist to complete this activity! Use color, pens, and work neatly to create a final product. You will need to select at least 6 quotes from your preparation activity that provide descriptions of something on the map. Once you have drawn the element on the map, draw a line to it and write the quote, **properly cited**, linking the drawing to the text. (i.e. if you find a quote that describes a specific tree's location, draw that tree and then write the quote next to the tree to demonstrate how you knew the location)

Look through chapters 1-2 for details on the setting. Then, copy quotes into the correct category below. You need to find a minimum of 6 quotes; however, an A map would include closer to 10. **Make sure to cite each quote (Golding #).**
