Assignment: Select one scene, or 200 lines, from Shakespeare's "Midsummer Night's Dream" and turn it into a comic strip. Make sure that your project fulfills the following requirements:

- Project is on plain white 8.5" x 11" (or bigger) paper
- Clearly states what act and scene the comic represents
- Covers an entire scene or 200 lines of text
- Includes a minimum of 8 boxes
- Includes color drawings, computer images, or magazine cutouts
- Accurately depicts the majority of events depicted in the chosen scene
- Shows creativity and a clear understanding of the text
- Is clean and thoughtful work that depicts effort and time

You may choose to make your comic one of the following:

- **Traditional:** Organizes and illustrates the scene using original text and characters
- **Adapted—Modern Day:** Organizes and illustrates the scene using modern interpretations of text and characters
- **Adapted—Personified Animals/Objects:** Organizes and illustrates the scene using the original text (or a modern interpretation) with characters that are not human
